**Approval of Minutes:** Minutes from the November 30<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved.

## School Update:

Kane's Boosterthon was a success! Kane raised over \$11,000. The Dance Party was held on January 19<sup>th</sup> in the gym. Kane is going to try and push our date until the Spring next year so that we can do something outside.

Covid cases in the school have gone down significantly since coming back after break.

Mask mandate will remain in place until February 28th, as of right now.

Testing: The Superintendent is working with School Committee on making a decision as to whether Marlborough will continue to test and stay or not.

NWEA is just about wrapped up for the mid-year assessment in both Math and ELA. Kane uses this data for intervention groups, SST process, and to see student growth in these academic areas.

Kane is also conducting ACCESS testing. This takes the month of January. Kane teachers are doing their best to catch up missed tests by absent students. The original window has been extended to March 4<sup>th</sup> due to Covid.

MCAS is still scheduled during its normal time. Marlborough doesn't have definite dates set as a district.

The first round of Kane's before and after school intervention is slated to end the week of January 31st. Next round starts February 7th, and these groups will be based on the latest round of NWEA data.

Winterfest was cancelled due to Covid. PTO is hoping for a Springfest or something similar but there is a chance the event may need to be skipped for one more year.

Kane's second book fair will be coming in March with a Family Night and book distribution.
