

VOTING METHOD

(School Governance and By Laws)

VOTING METHOD

- 1. All official actions of the School Committee must be by vote and the action recorded in the minutes.
- 2. Action can only be taken at an official meeting at which a quorum is present. A quorum is defined as four members of the full school committee.
- 3. All votes on motions and resolutions shall be by a show of hands and so recorded.
- 4. A roll call may be requested by any School Committee member at any time before or immediately following a vote and is not debatable.
- 5. All members present must vote. Votes may be either "Yes," "No," or "Abstain."
- 6. The affirmative vote of a majority of all of the members of the School Committee in attendance at a meeting shall be necessary to adopt any motion, resolution, or matter before it.
- 7. A majority vote of the full committee is required when voting to change a policy or a bylaw, initiate a new policy or by-law, or to employ or dismiss the Superintendent of Schools.
