SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETINGS

- 1. The School Committee will transact all business at official meetings of the Committee. These may be either regular or special meetings, defined as follows:
 - Regular Meeting: the usual official legal action meeting, held regularly
 - <u>Special Meeting:</u> an official legal action meeting called between scheduled regular meetings to consider specific topics.
- 2. Every meeting of the School Committee, regular or special, will be open to the public unless an executive session is held in accordance with state law.
- 3. Standing Sub-Committee and Ad-Hoc Committee meetings will be scheduled as needed.
- 4. In an emergency, a public body shall post notice as soon as reasonably possible prior to the meeting. Notice shall be printed in a legible, easily understandable format and shall contain the date, time and place of the meeting and listing of topics that the chair reasonable anticipates will be discussed at the meeting.
- Between meetings, the Superintendent take action of an emergency nature if conditions warrant, but the Superintendent will report such actions at the next School Committee meeting.
