SCHOOL HOURS POLICY

- 1. The Marlborough School Committee will set school hours to meet the standards regulated by the State Department of Education. Any variance of these hours must be approved by the Committee. The Committee delegates to the Superintendent of Schools the authority to close school or effect early dismissal in an emergency situation (See 4.200 School Cancellation).
- 2. No individual class or classroom will be dismissed by a teacher, without permission of the building administrator.
- 3. Student Instructional Day will align to the collective bargaining contracts in effect.
- 4. Scheduled Early Dismissal per District Calendar approved yearly by the School Committee (not weather related or emergency).
- 5. In a declared federal, state or local emergency this policy may be altered by the Superintendent with approval from the School Committee and a waiver may be requested from the State.
