DESIGNATION OF VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

While students may apply to any vocational school, that accepts applications from non-resident students, a district, through its school committee, may designate a specific vocational school as a "preferred" vocational school for the purposes of Chapter 74 Non-Resident Student Tuition Program.

MPS designates Assabet Valley Regional Technical High School (AVRTHS) as its preferred vocational high school for the community of Marlborough. Students must first apply to AVRTHS before applying to any other vocational school. Failure to first apply to AVRTHS may result in the Superintendent disapproving an application for non-resident tuition to another vocational school.
