

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Last night the School Committee voted to bring our Hybrid Students back to school in a staggered schedule starting on Feb. 22nd. The following schedule will be in place:

February 22nd: Cohort B week; Grades 3, 8, and 12 return to school.

March 1st: Cohort A week; Grades 3, 4, 7, 8, 9, 12 return to school.

March 8th: Cohort B week; All hybrid students in Cohort B return to school.

March 15th: Cohort A week; All hybrid students in Cohort A return to school.

If you are traveling over the February vacation, please follow the advisory and test before returning to the classroom. If testing results are delayed for a day or two; please do not send your students to school while you are waiting for results.
