

HIGH SCHOOL PROMOTION / GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS
(Instruction)

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1. Yearly Course Load and Promotion Requirements

In order to graduate, a student must accumulate a minimum of ninety-six (96) credits during grades 9-12, must carry & pass the minimum number of credits per year as noted below and must meet Program of Studies requirements as outlined, regarding CORE subjects and electives.

Students must carry a minimum amount of 24 credits per year.

2. Credit and Course Distribution Requirements

A. In order to graduate, a student must accumulate a minimum of 96 credits during grades 9-12. Within these totals, a certain number of units must be taken and a passing grade must be attained. The High School Principal has the discretion to approve alternative academic pathways.

English	4 years
Mathematics	4 years
Science & Technology/Engineering	3 years
History & Social Sciences	3 years
World & Classical Languages	2 years
Fine Arts	1 year
Wellness/Physical Education	4 half years (1 semester per year=8 credits)
