As a reminder, on March 21st, 22nd, and 23rd, our 10th grade students and some other new students to Marlborough will be participating in our annual English Language Arts MCAS. This assessment is considered a graduation requirement for our 10th graders. On these days, all students who are taking the MCAS will arrive to school for our typical start time of 7:15 a.m. All other students who are NOT testing on these days will arrive at a later time. The bus company has been notified of these changes and two bus runs will occur - one for tested students at the normal time, and one for non-tested students at a delayed time.

On Tuesday, March 21st: Students taking the test will arrive at 7:15 a.m.; students NOT taking the MCAS will arrive at 10:15 a.m. (3 hour delay)

On Wednesday, March 22nd: Students taking the test will arrive at 7:15 a.m.; students NOT taking the MCAS will arrive at 10:15 a.m. (3 hour delay)

On Thursday, March 23rd: Students taking the test will arrive at 7:15 a.m.; students NOT taking the MCAS will arrive at 9:30 a.m. (2 hour delay)
