MPS Meal Continuity Plan

During the extended school closure caused by COVID-19 concerns, the Marlborough Public Schools has pledged to continue providing breakfast and lunch to all families in our community. Meals are available at **no charge** for anyone who is 18 years old or younger. Anyone who wish to have access to a meal may do so without any application or identification process. Meals are available to all Marlborough families, regardless of school enrollment status or any income eligibility status during the regular school year. This includes families from other schools in the community, such as IC and AMSA.

There are two ways for the community to access school meals during this time:

Community-wide Drop Off Locations:

The district is utilizing school buses in routes similar to its elementary school routes to deliver meals to families Monday through Friday (except on school-observed holidays). Buses will stop at multiple different bus stops throughout the community. To view the list of routes and stops, [please click here](#).

Breakfast runs will start at **8:30 AM**

Lunch runs will start at **11:45 AM**

To avoid missing the bus, please plan to be at the stops at these times, as we anticipate that the bus routes will be significantly shorter than during a regular school day.

Pick Up Locations:

Meals will be available at all three elementary schools, at Whitcomb, and at the High School, between 8:30 AM and 1 PM Monday through Friday (except on school-observed holidays). If you prefer to pick up a meal rather than to receive one at a community-wide drop off location, please contact one of the schools below to inform them of when you'll be stopping by and how many meals you will need. A staff member will plan to bring a meal to your car.
