HiSET Preparation (formerly GED):

The High School Equivalency Test (HiSET) provides students the opportunity to earn a high school credential. This credential is recognized as a key to employment opportunities, career advancement, and further education. The test consists of five parts in the areas of mathematics, writing, science, social studies, and reading. Students may also use this class as preparation for college entry. Materials will be provided. There is no cost for the class although regular attendance is expected.

English for the Workplace (ESL):

English for the Workplace provides students with instruction in conversational English as well as reading and writing. Content is geared to helping the students function more easily in the day-to-day world - in the community (grocery, child's school, doctor's office), and at work. Materials will be provided.
